Please be advised that included in the Summary Statement of Revenue, Expenses and Changes in Net Assets, the Agency has restatements within its Other Net Assets Changes line. The Agency has historically recorded interest expense related to long term debt as it was paid. The prior years refinancing of certain long term bonds has caused a material change in the principal and interest portions of debt service. The Agency accrued related interest expense at year end and restated its prior year beginning Net Assets (decrease of \$212,804 as of January 1, 2012). This accrual also resulted in an increase in net position in 2012 of \$18,152 (see footnote 16 located within the certified auditors report).
